



## Self Guided Walks on Pitcairn

Please take great care when exploring. Pitcairn is a rugged island with steep hills and dangerous cliffs. If you are walking alone always let someone know where you are going and when you expect to return.

### DOWN ISAACS (moderate)

A rocky shore with natural rockpools. Look out for Sally Lightfoot crabs and small fishes in the pools.

Route: Concrete road, rough uneven paths, some steep terrain. Sea conditions can affect this walk.

### THE EDGE (easy)

Fabulous views of Bounty Bay and the peak at Ship's Landing. See an original wooden longboat, located above the road. View the site of the Bounty wreckage. Learn about the original Bounty settlers from commemorative plaques.

Route: Relatively flat walk, mostly concreted path.

### CHRISTIAN'S CAVE (moderate/difficult)

Follow the Eco Trail to the cave in the cliff where Fletcher Christian is reputed to have spent time contemplating his fate whilst keeping a lookout for ships. Fantastic views over Adamstown. Route: Concrete road, rough uneven paths, some steep terrain.

### TEDSIDE (moderate)

A scenic route over the top of the island with the possibility of encountering Miz T on the way. There are fascinating volcanic rock formations on the shore, a blow hole and numerous rockpools to explore. Route: Rough uneven paths, very steep terrain, exposed coastal rocks.

### HIGHEST POINT (moderate)

A scenic route to the island's highest point (347 m above sea level). Take a look at John Adams' grave when leaving Adamstown. Take a selfie at the top with the 'Signpost to the World' to show others you made it!

Route: Rough uneven paths, steep terrain.

### ST PAUL'S POOL (moderate/difficult)

A large pool 25 m long and 2-3 m deep, filled by overtopping waves. Lots of fishes, corals, sea cucumbers and even lobsters. Great for snorkelling, but please take great care!

Route: Concrete road, rough uneven paths, steep terrain.
